

BHUBANESWAR: All religious places and shopping malls in Odisha will remain shut till June 30 in view of rising Covid-19 cases. "All religious places/places of worship and shopping malls will remain closed till June 30," said a Special Relief Commissioner (SRC) notification on Monday. All cinema halls, gyms, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars,

auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places would remain closed till June 30, it added. Meanwhile, Chief Secretary Asit Tripathy asked the departments to organise the ward-level Covid committee meetings this week in both the rural and urban areas to spread awareness. An aware and alert community could achieve wonders in the fight against this unseen enemy, he added.

Lockdown extended till June 30 in Bengal

Just as Kolkata was resuming activities on June 8 with restaurants and malls opening up, West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday announced an extension of lockdown in the state till June 30. However, this pertains to containment zones. The movement of people on the road will be restricted from 9 pm to 5 am apart from essential services.



"The lockdown has been extended till the 30th of June. Wear masks and maintain social distancing," she said. The decision was taken considering the rising cases in the state as people have started going outdoors in larger numbers. Also, as religious places have opened up, Mamata announced not over 25 persons can enter any religious place at any given time. The same rule of 25 persons applies to guests at weddings and people attending last rite ceremonies.

As for migrant workers, trains will come in till June 10. Over 9 lakh migrant work-

ers have returned to West Bengal thus far. Mamata said migrant workers who are in West Bengal do not want to go back to their states.

She announced her state has received a soft loan of Rs850 crore from the World Bank from the Rs1,050 crore loan that the state had asked for. West Bengal is also reeling in the aftermath of cyclone Amphan which lashed out at West Bengal on May 20.

Despite the difficulties, the West Bengal CM announced her party the Trinamool Congress will hold their yearly Martyr's Day rally on July 21. "We will organise the July 21 rally. Let's see what happens. As local trains and metro trains cannot be used, we need to see where they can ply so that accidents don't happen. We can avoid the major roads and use by-lanes for the cycles. Police have been asked to make the notification," added Mamata.

The TMC supremo said her party is a collective family, hence they needed to discuss a virtual rally. The BJP can afford to hold a virtual rally but the TMC could not.

DEVE GOWDA TO CONTEST RAJYA SABHA ELECTIONS

Rajya Sabha on its own. But in a tactical move, the Congress decided to give its surplus votes to the former PM. The BJP, which too has surplus votes, decided not to put up a third candidate, making his victory easy.

If he wins, this will be the second Rajya Sabha entry for 87-year-old Gowda, the first time being in 1996 as PM.

In the 2019 Lok Sabha poll, Gowda was defeated in Tumakuru constituency by BJP's GS Basavraj by over 13,000 votes.

BJP files Kadadi, Gasti Meanwhile, the BJP sprang a surprise by confirming the names of Eranna Kadadi and Ashok Gasti as the party's nominees for the two Rajya Sabha seats. The announcement shocked senior leaders as several prominent front-runners were sidelined to pave way for second-rung leaders within the party.

Eranna Kadadi, 55, who began his political career in 1989, has strong roots in the RSS and worked his way up the BJP ladder.

Ashok Gasti, 55, hails from Raichur and also came through the ranks in the BJP after a stint with the ABVP. **The Congress has fielded veteran leader and a former leader of the opposition in the 16th Lok Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge, who on Monday filed his nomination as the party's candidate for the June 19 Rajya Sabha polls from Karnataka.**

THREE-DAY DARSHAN REHEARSAL BEGINS AT TIRUPATI HILL SHRINE

TIRUPATI: Ahead of allowing devotees' entry from June 11 after a nearly 80-day-long lockdown ban, a 3-day trial run of darshan began at Lord Venkateswara temple at Tirumala on Monday with staff and others attached to it following strict protective measures. 6,000 employees were permitted into the over 2000-year-old hill temple complex shrine with time slot free darshan, a temple official told PTI. Before making the offerings at the hundi, all devotees cleaned their hands with sanitiser. On Monday, visitors had to offer worship to the presiding deity of Lord Venkateswara from the 'Dwarapalakas Mandapam' itself. Meanwhile, the Shri Amarnath Barani Langars Organisation has suggested the cancellation of the upcoming annual pilgrimage to the holy cave shrine of Amarnath in south Kashmir Himalayas. The 42-day yatra was scheduled to begin from the twin tracks of Pahalgam in Anantnag and Baltal in Ganderbal, J&K on June 23, but the Shri Amarnathji Shrine Board headed by LG GC Murmu has said the appropriate decision on it would be taken after a fresh review of the situation.
